



4 billion to build solar and energy storage projects

The EU has today (23 November) launched a grant funding opportunity worth EUR4 billion (US\$4.4 billion) for upstream and downstream clean energy projects, including energy storage.

Developers plan to build 4.4 GW of new natural gas-fired capacity in the United States during 2025: 50% from simple-cycle combustion turbines and 36% from combined-cycle power blocks.
