Why did Abkhazia lose electricity?

Does Abkhazia have electricity?

"Currently,there is no electricitythroughout the entire territory of the republic." Abkhazian authorities said Russia suspended its financial aid to the cash-strapped region on Dec. 5,including crucial funding for the energy sector.

Why did Abkhazia buy electricity from Russia?

Abkhazia had been purchasing electricity from Russia since Nov. 1 due to an energy deficitcaused by low water levels at the Enguri dam,which supplies the region's largest hydroelectric facility.
