For connections in the DC side of a PV system (charge controller, DC loads, inverter inputs), we recommend wires with a temperature rating equal to or superior to 90°C.

A dc cable is responsible for connecting solar panels to each other and to the solar inverter. DC cables are single-core copper cables that are insulated and sheathed.



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
