

Starting with less than 50 MW at the beginning of the 2010s, mostly from isolated systems, solar photovoltaic power reached over 50 GW of installed capacity by early 2025--an ...

Distributed solar generation capacity grew from less than 1 gigawatt (GW) in 2018 to 40 GW in 2025 through June, accounting for 43% of all electricity capacity additions over that period.
