The first GSM base stations were opened in Tallinn in August of the same year. This marked the beginning of Estonia's transition to modern mobile communication systems.

The National Telecommunications act in the second period of Estonian independence granted a monopoly on international and local fixed line telephony to Estonian Telecom (Eesti Telecom). In the process of privatization, a concession was granted to liberalize mobile, CATV and packet-switched telecommunications. This concession was critical for developing a competitive market. Three licensed mobile operators encouraged one of the highest rates of mobile telephony penetration in the world. CA...

Here, Broadcast media include the publicly owned broadcaster, Eesti Rahvusringhaaling (ERR), operates 3 TV channels and 5 radio networks; growing number of private commercial radio stations ...

Beginning with a satellite link and widespread undersea leased line connectivity, Estonia connected with the rest of the world.
