What are the new grant schemes for solar energy in Malta?

The government of Malta launched six new grant schemes to incentivise the production, storage and use of renewable energy as part of the EUR9 million investment. The aid for solar energy will accommodate households with already existing systems to utilise battery powered systems and help new families setup the installation of new solar panel systems.

Does Malta offer a government rebate scheme for solar panels?

What if a photovoltaic system is allocated a feed-in tariff?

If the photovoltaic installation was allocated a feed-in tariff, the guaranteed period should be expired. Option A - PV system with standard solar inverter: 50% of eligible costs up to a maximum of Euro 2,500 per system and Euro 625/kWp.

Who is eligible for a photovoltaic tariff scheme?

This scheme is funded through national funds and applies to private individuals (natural persons) for use on their residential properties, and for organisations that are not carrying out an economic activity, provided that photovoltaic installation should have no active feed-in tariff allocation.
