The project site is on Majuro, an atoll island in the North Pacific. The site is a fuel tank farm that stores diesel fuel for power generation and transport. It was built in 1981 to applicable US standards.

Island communities like Majuro in the Marshall Islands face unique energy challenges. With limited land availability and high fuel transportation costs, traditional power solutions often prove inefficient.

All required materials for the floating solar PV plant at the MWSC water reservoirs have been received in Majuro. Demolition of gensets 3 and 4 under the EPC contract has begun at the MEC power plant.

The following sections present the results which highlight the ability of the Majuro network to operate with 20% of its generation output being provided by VRE, in this case solely from PV generation.

Currently and for nearly the past two years, virtually all power for the capital is supplied by rental generator units in containers leased from the South Pacific-based Aggreko Co.
