Can you grow crops under photovoltaic panels?

Research indicates that growing crops beneath photovoltaic displays can actually yield a distinct set of agricultural and environmental benefits. Thanks to the shade provided by the panels, for example, the soil can retain more water, meaning it needs less irrigation.

Are solar panels good for agrivoltaic crops?

Can solar panels help grow plants?

And certain crops appear to thrive when grown in such environments, according to a number of recent studies. Solar panels have to sometimes be elevated or suspended to allow plants to grow beneath them. Another option is putting them on the roofs of greenhouses.

How do agrivoltaic solar panels work?

(Let's Get Technical!) In agrivoltaics, solar panels are typically mounted on structures above crops or grazing areas. These panels generate electricity while simultaneously allowing crops to grow underneath.
