

The sustainable industrial and socio-economic development of São Tomé and Príncipe (STP) is heavily dependent on reforming the energy sector and transitioning from an almost complete reliance on ...

Similarly, PANEE sets specific targets for energy efficiency in line with STP's published NDC. This includes an 8.7 percent reduction in energy demand by 2030 and 12.9 percent reduction by 2050.

This is intended to reduce the dependence on fossil fuels in the country's energy matrix and, simultaneously, to guarantee the security of supply by promoting its balance.
