High temperatures have varying degrees of impact on the performance of various solar panel models. If you reside in a hot climate, solar panels with a low temperature coefficient should be considered. Even at extreme temperatures, these more expensive panels perform admirably.

Does heat affect a solar panel?

In the UK, around 40% of a solar panel system's energy is generated in the summer (see chart below), showing its strong performance in warmer months.

How can I improve my solar panel performance during hot weather?

To boost your solar panel performance during hot weather, start by ensuring proper ventilation beneath your panels. A gap of 4-6 inches between your roof and panels allows airflow that can reduce operating temperatures by up to 10-17°F. Regular cleaning becomes especially important during summer, as dust and debris can trap heat.

Do solar panels get hot?
