Windows & Skylights Tax Credit This tax credit is effective for products purchased and installed between January 1, 2023, and December 31, 2025.

For the tax year 2025, the federal solar tax credit equals 30% of solar installation costs, directly reducing your federal income tax liability. Here's an example of how the solar tax credit ...

If you're considering solar control or safety solar control window film for your home, you may be eligible for a tax credit up to 30% of the cost of the improvement, to an annual maximum tax credit of \$1,200 ...

Solar rebates, tax credits, sales tax exemptions and other incentives vary significantly from state to state. Arizona, Hawaii, Massachusetts, New Mexico, New York, South Carolina and Utah...

The federal solar tax credit for homeowner-owned systems is no longer available. If you're reading this after 2025, use this article to understand how the credit changed--and evaluate ...

If you invest in renewable energy for your home such as solar, wind, geothermal, fuel cells or battery storage technology, you may qualify for an annual residential clean energy tax credit.

With the federal credit disappearing, homeowners will need to rely more heavily on state and local incentives, financing tools and the steadily falling cost of equipment.
