



The largest battery energy storage project in East Africa

It will be the largest standalone battery energy storage system in Africa. Red Sands BESS will use approximately 5 hectares (12 acres) and will connect to the grid through the Eskom ...

The Red Sands project was originally developed by African Green Ventures, which Globeleq acquired last year from Magnora, a Norwegian company listed on the Oslo Stock Exchange.
