



Vietnam has 5G base stations for communication

Vietnam's leading mobile operators--Viettel, VNPT, and MobiFone--are accelerating their 5G expansion, deploying a total of 11,000 base stations throughout the country.

Vietnam's three major mobile operators have collectively rolled out 11,000 5G base stations, and the government expects that figure to nearly double by the end of 2025.

Between February and December 2025, Viettel installed an additional 23,500 5G base stations across Vietnam.

The telecom operator has plans to install 20,000 5G base transceiver stations this year. This move is expected to boost current data transmission speeds by more than 2.5 times.

According to Nguyen Anh Dung, Director of Enterprise Customer Division at VNPT, the company is expected to install approximately 20,000 new 5G base stations across the country to ...
