

# Why do photovoltaic panel tests need to be done at night

When a manufacturer wants to test their new solar panels, the IEC creates these test conditions in a laboratory, puts the solar panels under that 1000 W/m<sup>2</sup> light, and measures the solar panel output.

**Dark Environment:** The test must be conducted in complete darkness--either at night or under light-sealed conditions--so the panel's subtle glow isn't overwhelmed by ambient light.

While photovoltaic modules don't generate power after sunset, nighttime conditions like temperature swings and condensation buildup can accelerate material degradation.
