

Wind solar storage and transmission in portugal by 2025

How much electricity does Portugal generate in 2025?

In the period from January to August 2025, Portugal generated 33,107 GWh of electricity, with renewables accounting for 76.9% of total generation--the fourth-highest share in Europe, following Norway, Denmark, and Austria.

What will happen if solar and wind generation grow by 2030?

The growth of solar and wind generation by 2030 could result in 3-5 TWh of curtailment which storage can capture during solar peaks, then discharge to meet evening demand when renewable generation declines.

Is Portugal a renewable country?

From January to July, Portugal achieved a 79.6% renewable share in electricity generation, maintaining its position as the fourth-ranked country in Europe, behind Norway, Denmark, and Austria.

Can storage replace thermal generation in Portugal?

The pursuit of economic viability by storage facility owners will inherently lead to charging during low-cost hours and discharging during hours that are more economically attractive. Storage can replace thermal generation in constraint markets, easing the grid and supporting Portugal's 2040 phase-out target.
